

Marrying on Norfolk Island

People intending to marry on Norfolk Island must file a "Notice of Intended Marriage" one month prior to the intended date of marriage.

The notice must be completed by both Bride and Groom, witnessed by an appropriate person.

1. First marriage for both bride and groom, provide:
 2. +
 - (a) Birth Certificate
 - (b) Fee for marriage and lodging Notice of Intended Marriage \$200
 - (c) 2 Witnesses must be present at ceremony
3. Second marriage for either party, provide:
 - (a) Birth Certificates
- (b) Proof of termination of previous marriage, namely, decree absolute or death certificate
- (c) Fee for marriage and lodging "Notice of Intended Marriage" \$200
- (d) 2 Witnesses must be present at ceremony

The notice can also be faxed to the Registry Office (Fax int+ 6723 22403) BUT you must bring the original copy to Norfolk with you.

Costing is \$200. This includes:

Lodgment of notice and for a civil service – if in a church a donation is made.
Also need to notify the registrar if a celebrant is required or not.
